SUMMERTIME PET EMERGENCIES AND HELPFUL TIPS



As temperatures climb, we see an increase in cases related to summer hazards. Common emergencies this time of year include toxin ingestions (BBQ scraps, yard chemicals, and plants), heatstroke, blue-green algae toxicity, insect bites, allergic reactions, and injuries from outdoor activities.

Watch for Treated Lawns & Parks

Many neighborhoods and parks apply pesticides and herbicides in summer. Keep pets indoors during treatments, and check that the area is safe before letting them outside.

Toxic Plants & Garden Hazards

Summer gardens may include toxic plants and mulch. Ingesting things like cocoa mulch or sago palm can be dangerous-be mindful of what's growing in your yard or what pets may encounter on walks.

Seasonal Allergies & Insect Reactions

Just like us, pets can react to summer allergens and insect stings. Look out for itching, swelling, hives, or difficulty breathing-these may be signs of an allergic reaction that needs urgent care.

Leash Up for Summer Adventures

More time outside means more chances for the unexpected. Keep pets leashed to help prevent encounters with wildlife, traffic, or aggressive animals.
